

# Holiday Planner

Make your own cute holiday planner out of a composition notebook to help you stay organized through the holiday season! I've included several different title cover choices in colors that should work with everyone's color themes. Here's what you need!

### Supplies

- 1 composition notebook
- 1 title cover printable, in the color of your choice (Print on cardstock with a laser printer for best results)
- 1 set of the tabs printable (Print on cardstock with a laser printer for best results)
- Coordinating cardstock paper and embellishments of your choice
- Scissors or paper trimmer
- Adhesive (a permanent tape runner works best)
- Stapler

### Directions

1. Measure the length of your composition notebook from top to bottom. Write this down.
2. Choose two pieces of coordinating cardstock. (For best results, choose a solid and a pattern) Your cardstock will need to be at least 8x8. My cardstock was 12x12 so I will need to trim it down more later.
3. Cut a 4" piece of the cardstock you chose to cover the top portion of the composition notebook cover. Cut the other piece of cardstock to cover the bottom portion of the composition notebook cover. Adhere them to the notebook with your adhesive. Trim any excess with scissors or craft knife.
4. Each title printable cover page actually includes 2 titles. Choose the one you like most and cut it down to fit the cover of your notebook. I cut mine to 6x3. Adhere it to your notebook, being sure to leave space for your coordinating cardstock to show through.
5. Add embellishments like ribbons, stickers, die cuts and flowers anywhere you choose. (optional)
6. Next, cut the tabs apart. Be sure to leave white space ABOVE the wording. This will allow you to fold the tabs in half. You can have as many tabs as you want in your notebook.
7. Open your composition notebook and grab the first 2 pages. You want 2 pages for each tab for durability. Take the tab that you want to come first and staple it to the pages with 2 staples. I chose to put my tabs in my notebook chronologically according to how the holiday feel on the calendar and how I would tackle my tasks. The order of the tabs is up to you.
8. Skipping a few pages in the notebook, secure the next tab to the 2 pages. Continue doing this, making sure you cascade the tabs down the side of the notebook so you can see them.
9. If you would like, you can add pockets to the tab pages to hold magazine cutouts, receipts or whatever you need to carry along with you.
10. Don't forget to cover the back of the notebook with a piece of cardstock of your choice. That's it! Now you can tackle the holidays in an organized way!
